“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

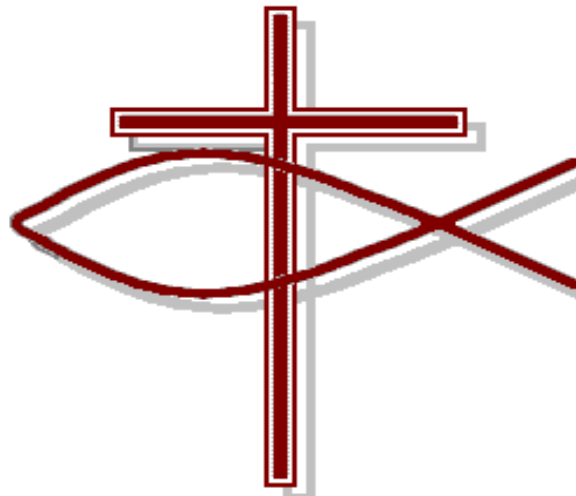
Through this verse we can see that the Christian faith is really simple because all we have to do is believe in Christ and his sacrifice and we will be saved for eternity.

God is perfect in righteousness and holiness.

He is a good God who did not create evil because evil is the absence of good.

It is important to realize that in today's world, evil didn't come from God but came from man. For man was created in God's image to serve and glorify him. God created man perfect but he also created man with a choice. For if man weren't created with out a choice then they would have been created as robots. Therefore with the free choice that man was given they ate the fruit that came from the serpent and thereby letting sin enter the world.

In this regard we reject the error of the Pelagians, who say that this sin is only a matter of imitation.

Is God good or Evil?

When discussing God it is important to understand who God is, in fact God is a good God. Often times God is mistaken as being evil because we live in such a corrupt world. But rather it is important to realize that God is a good God because whereas there is evil, evil was not created, in fact, evil is just the absence of good.

The Triune God:

Who is God? And if Christians say they only believe in one God why do they always speak of three? Well it is important to understand that God is three distinct persons that are the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Father adopts us as his children by his grace, the Son died on the cross to save us from our sins, and the Holy Spirit regenerates us by the preaching of the word!
